FAMILY SIZZLER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

PROBLEM:

ACTION:

Unusual noises.

Stop ride (release rotation button).

Ride will not stop.

Release rotation button. Push red stop button. Turn off key. Turn off main electrical-disconnect at rear of control stand. Ride will coast to stop in approximately 1 1/2 rotations.

Procedure explained.

Let go off rotation button:

Large red palm button:

Turn off key:

Turn off main electrical

disconnect:

This will turn off drive motors. Cuts off power to drive motor contact or coil. Cuts off power to drive motor contact or coil.

Shuts off power to ride.

It is imperative that the lap bars be checked after all the passengers are loaded to be sure they are down in the customer's lap. We have had one instance where the lap bar was not pushed down in the passengers lap and the child climbed out of the seat during operation.

Due to the seriousness of this, we would like to have you make sure that you operators understand that the ride must be operated in a professional manner, being very conscious of watching the passengers while they are riding the ride and make sure the lap bar is pressed down into their lap. If any passenger tries to get out, STOP THE RIDE.
